











Latin America is the region in the world with the highest number of women in prison for minor drug offenses

# PERCENTAGE OF WOMEN AND MEN INCARCERATED FOR DRUG-RELATED OFFENSES


AS A PROPORTION OF THE TOTAL INCARCERATED POPULATION
