

Context

Marsh Harbour, Abaco

Abaco is an island chain in the northern Bahamas. It is the second largest of the Bahamian islands and the third most populous (19,445). The islands have a rich history as a place of refuge dating back to the original settlers, the Lucayans around 700 AD to the Loyalists who fled the United States in 1783 following the American revolution, and in more modern times the migration of a large population of Haitians Nationals seeking a better way of life. Prior to hurricane Dorian in September of 2019, which dealt a devastating blow to the island chain, Abaco boasted a thriving economy. It is known as the boating capitol of the Bahamas. Other major industries include, fishing, farming, and tourism. Marsh Harbour is the administrative capital of the islands and home to the major Public Health facility for the community. It is the heart of the island, where a large segment of the population live and work. Hence why this community was chosen as the focal point for the development of the community-based intervention.

Fox Hill, New Providence

Fox Hill is one of many vibrant communities in Nassau and holds many traditions and historic buildings that brought all Bahamians together. It is stated in history that Fox Hillian slaves were emancipated a week later than the rest of the slaves living on the island of New Providence. As such this community boast of a rich history and culture. According to Census (2010), the Fox Hill community has 2452 households which serves as home to 9603 residents. 11% of the population is of Haltian descent. .more than 40% of the residents in this community experience economic hardship prior to COVID-19 and the pandemic exasperated the situation.



Development of the Project

Communities that Care Plan

PHASE 1: Assessment — The nature of the substance misuse problem /related harmful behaviors, Risk /protective factors. Community capacity for prevention (readiness / resources, mapping of resources)

PHASE 2: Capacity Building- Engage diverse community stakeholders. Develop/strengthen a prevention team, Raise community awareness

PHASE 3: Planning- (Who, What, Where) Prioritize Needs. Select the risk /protective factors, community develops a comprehensive approach to prevention, programs, and practices combine to reach people with different levels of risk using evidence based practices, logical model built and shared

PHASE 4: Implementation- Management and coordination of implementation Process (Who, What, Where)

PHASE 5: Evaluation- Systematically document prevention activities

- track adaptations. Continuously improve prevention programs/ practices.
Demonstrate the impact of a prevention program or practice on substance misuse and related behavioral health problems, Identify which elements of prevention plan are working well. Build credibility and support for effective prevention programming in the community hence advancing prevention efforts countrywide. Process/Outcome

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

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
